## A CULTURE OF SOLIDARITY

On the Feast of Corpus Christi, we read the account of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves. Jesus fed the multitude with five loaves and two fish. And the end of this passage is important: "And all ate and were satisfied. And they took up what was left over, twelve baskets of broken pieces." (Luke 9:17). Jesus asked the disciples to ensure that nothing was wasted: nothing thrown out! And there is this fact of the twelve baskets. Why twelve? What does it mean? Twelve is the number of the tribes of Israel, it represents symbolically the whole people. And this tells us that when the food was shared fairly, with solidarity, no one was deprived of what he needed, every community could meet the needs of its poorest members. Human and environmental ecology go hand in hand.

I would therefore like us all to make the serious commitment to respect and care for creation, to pay attention to every person, to combat the culture of waste and of throwing out so as to foster a culture of solidarity and encounter.
